Training. Volunteers are required to complete the First Tee Assistant Coach Training elearning course as well as SafeSport training.

When can I Volunteer? Programming runs from April to October. Instructional classes as well as practice opportunities are offered throughout the week and Friday Play Day is held each week. **Please note: we do not offer programming during the weeks that we host the Inspirato Colorado Open Championships:**
