- All supplies and equipment will be cleaned and sanitized before and after class.
- Participants MUST bring their own water bottle.
- Parents are welcome to watch from their vehicle, while observing all mandated social distancing guidelines.
- If the participant is not feeling well, do NOT come to class. Please STAY HOME.
