

SPECTATOR & HANDICAP CART POLICY

SPECTATORS:

Spectators are invited and encouraged to follow players as a gallery during the Inspirato Colorado Open Championships and admission is free.

Except for caddies, all spectators must stay out of the fairways and off of greens and tees during play. It is okay to gather near the tee and greens to watch, but we ask that they stay on the cart paths or rough while walking the course.

Spectators must respect the players and the tournament. Any spectator who is disruptive, abusive, or unruly with Colorado Open players, staff, or volunteers may be asked to leave the premises.

HANDICAP CARTS:

Spectators requiring motorized transportation due to sever physical disabilities must notify the Colorado Open Golf Foundation prior to the Championship and receive permission to rent a cart from the GVR GC.

There are a limited amount of carts available for spectators with disabilities. Handicap spectators must present their placard to the Tournament Director prior to getting a golf cart. Upon approval AND availability, the cart may be rented at the golf shop for a fee. Cart availability is evaluated daily and is not guaranteed.

Carts MUST remain on the cart path at all times

Carts will NOT be permitted in designated practice areas (e.g., range, putting green, etc.) at any time.

Individuals assume all risks incidental to spectating at these events and release the Colorado Open Golf Foundation, Inspirato, Colorado Golf Association (CGA), and Colorado Section of the PGA Boards of Directors, Trustees, and Tournament Committees from any and all liabilities.
