This month we're highlighting Cruz Abeyta, who joined First Tee – GVR for the first time this year. Cruz has shown steady improvement on the course and has stepped confidently into new opportunities, including the GVR Caddie Program. His enthusiasm, work ethic, and positive attitude have made him a standout in his first year with us.

Here's Cruz in his own words:

"This was my first year participating in the First Tee program at GVR, and I worked with at least four different instructors. All of them were highly trained, knowledgeable, mentoring, and patient. We worked in groups of our own age and sometimes individually. I'll add that I had never had prior golf experience, but with the help of the coaches I quickly learned that I could do this and that I enjoy it.

Because I didn't have my own golf set, they were kind enough to lend me a set temporarily until I secured one on my own. I tried out for my first tournament during my first year in the program. Unfortunately, it was not my day to qualify, but there is always next year, and I plan to return.

After gaining confidence through the golf program, I joined the Caddie Program at GVR. This program is highly competitive, and in the beginning I thought I wouldn't have many opportunities to work. I soon learned that to work as a caddie you need to have knowledge of the game of golf, so my experience playing golf went hand in hand with the training. I was taught to be efficient and to do things the right way the first time, but more than anything, not to forget to have fun. Manners are number one on the golf course, and everyone is nice and polite. I made friends with everyone I caddied for, and I felt like I had co-workers in the golf shop, the cafeteria, and with the outside staff who cleaned the carts. People recognized me and made me feel like I belonged there. It showed me that if you really want to be there and work hard, there is a place for you.

I want to thank everyone at both First Tee and GVR for their kindness and willingness to give me the opportunities I've had this year. I am sincerely grateful."
