Alumni Corner

Hunter Swanson joined First Tee – Green Valley Ranch at age 10 and stayed involved through his junior years before becoming a Division I golfer at the University of Colorado. Below is his story, in his own words.

My name is Hunter Swanson, and I am a current D1 collegiate golfer at the University of Colorado Boulder. I was introduced to the game through First Tee – Green Valley Ranch. No one in my family played golf, but with Green Valley Ranch Golf Club right next to our house and a First Tee chapter focused on youth, my parents decided to enroll me. They didn't do it just so I could learn golf—they wanted to make sure I learned life skills, and the First Tee's core values helped shape who I am today.

First Tee became more than a place where I took golf classes, it became my home. I spent more time at First Tee and Green Valley Ranch Golf Club than I did at my own house.

Through First Tee, I had opportunities such as competing in two First Tee National Championships, attending the Pebble Beach Pure Insurance Championship, and going on a retreat to Colorado Springs where I played golf at The Broadmoor with Annika Sorenstam. These were some of the best golf experiences of my life, and they also helped me build lasting relationships and meet influential people.

I also gained valuable experience volunteering through the Colorado Open Golf Championships, Food Bank of the Rockies, and the Denver Golf Expo. Volunteering showed me how much I enjoy helping others and giving back, and it played a big role in shaping me as a person.

I could go on and on about the experiences I've had through First Tee, but this is the short version. I would not be the person or golfer I am today without First Tee, and I am incredibly grateful to everyone who played a role in my journey.
