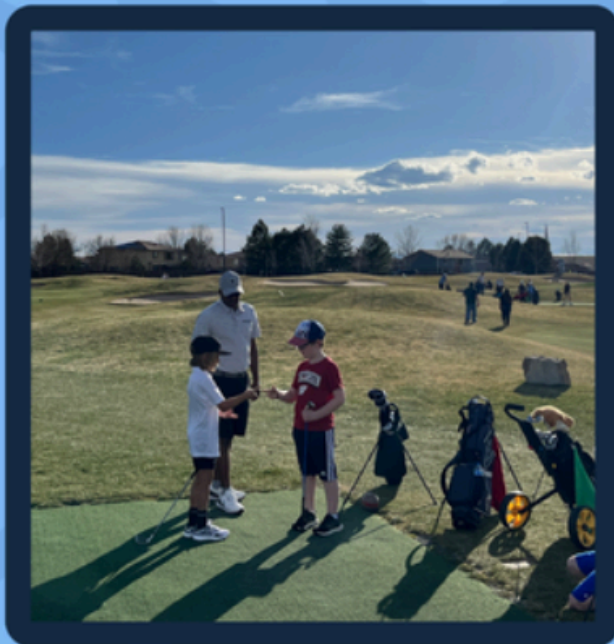

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE RINGER BOARD?

ANY FIRST TEE – GREEN VALLEY RANCH PARTICIPANT AGES 7–18 WITH AN ACTIVE 2026 ANNUAL FT – GVR MEMBERSHIP AND IS/WAS REGISTERED FOR A CLASS OR CAMP SESSION IN 2026. THE TWO AGE DIVISIONS WILL BE 7–11 AND 12–18 AND BASED ON YOUR AGE ON OCTOBER 2, 2026.



A season-long competition in which players can play in as many Friday Play Days as they want. The goal is to get the lowest possible score on each of the holes - 1 through 9 - over the course of the season. For example, if you make a 3 at least once on each of the 9 holes, your final score would be 27 or if your lowest score throughout the season on holes 1 through 7 is a 3 but you made a birdie on holes 8 and 9, your final score would be 25. The season-long competition will be based on total improvement of score after the first round played.

Emma Bryant has been part of First Tee – GVR since she was 5 years old, growing up in the program and developing both her game and confidence along the way. In 2018, she became the Colorado 5A State Individual Champion as a freshman. After high school she went on to play college golf at the University of Denver, continuing to build on that success.

Last year, Emma returned to First Tee – GVR as a coach, giving back to the program that helped shape her. She now works in the golf industry, staying closely connected to the game.

“The First Tee played a significant role in shaping who I am today, both on and off the golf course. It gave me the confidence to step outside of my comfort zone, meet new people, and build relationships with those from different backgrounds.

I learned respect for my peers and coaches, how to carry myself with professionalism, and how to understand others’ perspectives.

The program also taught me resilience. Golf constantly challenges you, and I learned how to handle setbacks, stay composed, and keep moving forward with a positive mindset.

Most importantly, First Tee showed me that who I am on the course and off the course can complement each other. The values I learned are the same ones I carry with me every day.”

Emma’s journey reflects the long-term impact of the program, from early introduction to a career in the game.

Colorado PGA / PGA Reach

The Colorado PGA and PGA REACH have been long-standing partners in growing the game and expanding opportunities for youth across our community.

As a founding board member of the Colorado Open Golf Foundation since 2003, the Colorado PGA has played a meaningful role in shaping the direction and impact of our organization. Since 2004, they have contributed more than \$180,000 in support of our programs and mission.

Through PGA REACH Colorado, an additional \$95,000 in grant funding has been invested in First Tee – Green Valley Ranch since 2009. This support has directly strengthened our ability to deliver accessible and impactful programming for the 3,783 children and their families we serve.
